

Community Literacy Award

The Department of Labour and Advanced Education Community Literacy Award provides you with the opportunity to nominate a person who has gone above and beyond the call of duty as a volunteer and who is deserving of recognition for his/her dedication to community-based literacy.

Criteria for this award are as follows:

- ▶ be a volunteer tutor or a network member
- ▶ have been involved in community-based literacy for at least 3 years
 - ▶ have regular involvement in community-based literacy activities
 - ▶ be an advocate on behalf of learners/adult literacy
- ▶ perform tasks in exemplary ways so that others acknowledge his/her skills and commitment

The nominations are held in the spring. The award is formally presented to the award recipient at the annual International Literacy Day Ceremony in September.
