Offered in Nova Scotia since 1969, the General Education Development (GED) is an international high school equivalency testing program for adults.

It consists of a series of five tests in the areas of social studies, science, mathematics, writing and reading.

The GED National Award for Outstanding Achievement is granted to the individual who achieves the highest score on the GED tests written in Nova Scotia. The award is presented at the International Literacy Day Celebration held in September.
